**Reminder: Admissions to school (Academic Year 19/20):** If your child was born between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 you must apply for a school place for your child for entry in the academic year September 2018. You will be able to apply on-line from 25<sup>th</sup> October. Please visit <a href="https://www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions">www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions</a> for further information. The deadline line date is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

#### Please remember the following:-

- It is the responsibility of parents/carers to apply for a school place by the deadline of 15 January 2019
- If your child is attending nursery classes within a primary school, you must still apply for a place in the main school
- You can list three different schools in order of preference. We strongly advise you to use all three preferences
- We advise you to enter your catchment (or designated) school as one of your preferences
- Attending your catchment school does not entitle you to free home to school transport if it is not your closest school and / under 2 miles away
- If your application is late, you are far less likely to get a place at one of your preferred schools.
