If you cannot collect tickets you can email the school office or phone school requesting tickets. Due to space restrictions tickets are limited to two per child for example: 1 evening and 1 afternoon / 2 afternoon / 2 evening

Tickets are 'first come, first served' basis. Evening tickets go very quickly (normally sold out by the next day) so if you can only go to the evening show then you must buy tickets on Monday 9th July! The performances are at **1.30pm and 6.15pm on Tuesday 17th July**.

Any tickets not collected by **3.30pm on Friday 13th July**, will be made available to parents who would like extra on **Monday 16th July**. Letters will go home with details about costumes for Year 6 soon and costumes will need to be in school (in a named plastic bag) on <u>Monday 9th July</u>.

Children will need to be dropped off at 5.30pm for the evening performance.

Children will go back to their classrooms after the performance and we ask parents to wait in the courtyard for their child to be handed over.

COMING UP...

Class 2 and 3 are having a special morning to celebrate the end of the year and to talk about **transition to Year 1**. This will take place on Monday 16th July from 8.50am. Parents are invited.

Year 5 will attend an Experience Day at DGS and SBS next Wednesday 11th July. Children are to arrive to school as normal and then walk up to the respective schools with our staff. Children must be wearing their school uniform, take basic school equipment (e.g. pencil case, pens, pencils) and take a packed lunch. They will be return to Ladygrove Park Primary School by 3pm.

*On **Monday** next week we have the Explorer Dome set up in the hall for Year 1 children. As a result, our hall will be unavailable for hot meals. Instead, brunch bags will be offered.
