Year five had a very enjoyable trip to the Living Rainforest on Wednesday. They were taken on tours of the two glasshouses and shown many different plants and animals including bright blue poison-dart frogs, a beautiful toucan. Children were all well behaved and listened intently as the tour guides explained the adaptations animals and plants have made to live in this environment. The guides were impressed with how much our children knew about the rainforest and made us proud. A big thank you to the parents who accompanied them on the trip.

Please can I remind everyone that **riding a bike or scooter** in school grounds is **NOT** allowed- as stated in the first newsletter of the year. Yesterday a child on a scooter collided with a young child in the school playground. This rule is for everyone's safety and I would appreciate you reiterate this message at home with your child. Thank you.

Bumped Heads - We are changing the way we notify parents/carers if your child bumps their head in school. You will still receive a first aid slip as normal but we are replacing our 'bumped head' stickers with a neon orange wrist band. The date and time will be recorded on the band and it is advisable for this to stay on your child for 72 hours so anyone can monitor any changes. I would like to reiterate that Parents are always contacted immediately if our first aiders are concerned about any injury your child experiences however, please remember that head injuries can be mild, moderate or severe and always seek medical advice if you are concerned about your child after a head injury. This change is not in response to any incident- just a prudent update to our protocol.

Children in Year 6 are currently writing applications if they want to become a **Digital Safety Leader**. Six leaders will work with myself and senior leaders through the year to ensure children and parents know how to be safe with their devices and while online. The six leaders will be chosen based on the content of their applications. These are still available from me in the office- to be returned by next Wednesday (2nd October). The successful candidates will be informed next Friday.

Similarly, Year 5 (five) children will be invited to become **Anti Bullying Ambassadors** next week now that our previous Year 6 (six) ambassadors have left. This will be through the same application process and 6 (six) children will lead on initiatives through the year to highlight the difference between being Rude, being Mean and Bullying and how the school deals with each.

The **PALS AGM** is taking place next week- 3rd October at 7.30pm at school. We gave our fond farewell to PALS Chair Ali Garraway last year and we have been looking for her replacement ever since. Please do approach anyone at school if you think you can **spare the time to Chair** this small but wonderful group of parents who make all the lovely PALS events happen at school.

Reminder: Admissions to school (Academic Year 20/19): If your child was born between 1st September 2015 and 31st August 2016 you must apply for a school place for your child for entry in the academic year September 2020. You will be able to apply on-line from 1st November 2019. Please visit www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions for further information. NB The deadline line date for online applications is 15th January 2020. Please remember the following:-

- It is the responsibility of parents/carers to apply for a school place by the deadline of 15 January 2020
- If your child is attending nursery classes within a primary school, you must still apply for a place in the main school
- You can list three different schools in order of preference. We strongly advise you to use all three preferences
- We advise you to enter your catchment (or designated) school as one of your preferences
- Attending your catchment school does not entitle you to free home to school transport if it is not your closest school and / under 2 miles away
- If your application is late, you are far less likely to get a place at one of your preferred schools.

Year 6 parents can now apply on line for secondary schools and the closing date is 31st October 2019. Remember, to ensure your child transfers to the school that you consider most appropriate, you must apply before the closing date.
