Choir had an amazing time at The Big Christmas Sing on Monday evening. After a long day of rehearsals, the event came together with a mix of schools singing solo items, audience carolling and massed choir items that were truly electrifying and echoed harmoniously round the beautiful Oxford Town Hall. Afterwards, the children all commented on how much fun they had had. Ladygrove choir was the last to sing, and as Mr Markham commented, "They saved the best for last!", which was so true; the children certainly saved their best singing for the event, I could not be prouder of them all! Tuesday saw Year 3, 5 and 6 take part in a **Skateability** workshop, provided by Team Rubicon. The children donned elbow and knees pads and a helmet to learn how to ride a skateboard. The coach, Adam, was very impressed with how quickly all of the children (most that had never ridden a skateboard before) grasped the various techniques. The children practiced jumping on with two feet (so the skateboard doesn't roll away), balancing on the board and then the tricky 'push and balance' while the skateboard is rolling. At the end of the session there was even time to practice some tricks! All of the children showed great perseverance when practicing the techniques and enjoyed the session very much!

Year 3 went out and about today exploring and mapping the man-made and natural features of our local landscape. The children gained fieldwork skills, using sketching and photography to gather evidence, before considering how these features might have changed over time. We studied the book 'Window' to inspire their ideas and to help predict what could happen to the view out of a window at school or home, over the next few years. Finally, the children represented their ideas through models and pictures, using their choice of art medium.

We had a **Yoga** teacher in school today giving children in Years 1 and 2 an introduction to Yoga. It was a story based approach for children-themed around the change of seasons into winter, hibernation and sharing amongst the woodland animals, weaving the web of interconnection and kindness. They also experienced relaxation to music under rainbow blankets that flow down from the sky to calm, reassure and relax them. They then headed back to class after some magic yoga spray to help spread the calm feelings and Yoga magic!

I'm very proud of the work done by the **House Captains** over the last few weeks as they prepared to give a presentation to our school governors. Danielle, Leah, Shalom, Mikey, Rowan and Jamie worked on the Chromebooks in collaboration using Google Slides. The final presentation on Wednesday night was slick and the governors were impressed with the content. Well done.

### Please remember the following:-

- It is the responsibility of parents/carers to apply for a school place by the deadline of 15 January 2020
- If your child is attending nursery classes within a primary school, you must still apply for a place in the main school
- You can list three different schools in order of preference. We strongly advise you to use all three preferences
- We advise you to enter your catchment (or designated) school as one of your preferences
- Attending your catchment school does not entitle you to free home to school transport if it is not your closest school and / under 2 miles away
- If your application is late, you are far less likely to get a place at one of your preferred schools.
