Covid updates As you will have heard, the Delta variant has caused set backs to national recovery during half term. Oxfordshire R is now between 1 and 1.2. The South and Vale again have the highest number of cases. Ladygrove estate itself sits at similar levels to areas of Oxford city, currently high in Oxfordshire, based on cases per 100k people. During half term there were 9 cases on the estate, 6 of which were households with children at the school. With all this in mind, protective measures and close attention to symptoms continue to help us avoid any closures at school. Please keep informing us of any tests taken, with either negative or positive results.
