#### **Covid update**

This week presented us with challenges around the changes to government expectations for schools even though there remain positive cases in the community. It is still the expectation that 'Test and Trace' are supposed to contact individuals who are in close contact, independently of the school. They only contact the school if they perceive that there is a spread which might be forming an outbreak. Therefore, to keep you informed, we have decided to send 'Inform Letters' if there is a child who was in contact with the class who subsequently was found to be positive. The Inform Letter is just for information because the child will have already been sent home or kept at home and **all other children will be expected at school unless they are symptomatic, found to be asymptomatic or for other legitimate absence reasons**. We discuss any perceived spread with Public Health but classes will be closed very rarely, in favour of maintaining or further strengthening our control measures.

Our Inclusion Team consists of the Assistant Headteacher for Inclusion, the Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities Co-ordinator (SENDCo), Inclusion HLTA/ELSA, and Inclusion Class teacher. The Assistant Headteacher for Inclusion is Carrie Barringer, the SENDCo is Carol Turner, our Inclusion HLTA and Emotional Literacy Support Assistant is Sarah Cheetham and the Inclusion Class Teacher is Amber Parsons. Our governor with responsibility for SEND is: Victoria Brown.

#### What expertise can we offer?

Carrie Barringer (Assistant Headteacher for Inclusion) manages the Inclusion team and leads with strategic planning for SEND. Carol Turner (SENDCo) has achieved the National Award for SENCo. Both our SENDCo and Assistant Headteacher for Inclusion have attended various training courses on SEND. Our Inclusion HLTA is very experienced working with children with autism and has training as an Emotional Literacy Support Assistant. Our Inclusion Class Teacher has a special interest in inclusion and SEND (particularly supporting pupils with dyslexia) and supports the staff with training and ideas for quality first teaching in the classroom.

**Reminder: Admissions to school (Academic Year 22/23):** If your child was born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018 you must apply for a school place for your child for entry in the academic year September 2022. You will be able to apply on-line from 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2021. Please visit <u>www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions</u> for further information. NB <u>The deadline line date for online applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2022.</u>

#### Please remember the following:-

- It is the responsibility of parents/carers to apply for a school place by the deadline of 15<sup>th</sup> January 2022
- If your child is attending nursery classes within a primary school, you must still apply for a place in the main school
- You can list three different schools in order of preference. We strongly advise you to use all three preferences
- We advise you to enter your catchment (or designated) school as one of your preferences
- Attending your catchment school does not entitle you to free home to school transport if it is not your closest school and / under 2 miles away
- If your application is late, you are far less likely to get a place at one of your preferred schools.
