Year 6 run the 'Mini Marathon'

Last year more than 100,000 children took part in the Virgin Money Giving Mini London Marathon in schools. This year, they are aiming to inspire 500,000 children to finish the event between Monday 27 September and Friday 22 October.

To complete the event, children needed to run/jog/walk 2.6 miles (all at once or over as many days as it takes). Year 6 did this in one go on the afternoon of Tuesday 12 October!

One mile is 8 laps of our field. 2 miles is 16 laps. 0.6 laps would then be 3/5 of 8 more laps.... round up to 5 laps. So, the children ran/jogged/walked a total of 21 laps to successfully complete this. We were extremely proud of their enthusiasm for this and their support for each other. Primary SWIFT Course

What is it?

SWIFT is a training programme for schools developed by the Communication and Interaction Service (C&I).

SWIFT provides the opportunity for schools to:

- Learn more about the children they support
- Promote a consistent approach across home and school
- Guide parents/carers through practical strategies they can use with their children
- Direct parents/carers to relevant resources
- Give parents/carers the opportunity to meet with other parents who have had similar experiences and to gain support and learn from each other

Who is it for?

Parents/carers who have a child on the autism spectrum or who has communication and interaction needs.

What does it cover?

SWIFT consists of four Modules that explore key aspects of autism, development and learning. Each Module has activities, films, key resources and strategies.

Module One: Understanding Autism
Module Two: Social Communication
Module Three: Sensory Processing
Module Four: Emotional Wellbeing
